Protected Areas



- 4,128 SSSIs: 104 have one or more herp feature
 - Only 6 with a reptile assemblage feature
 - 0 with adder as a feature
- Revision of SSSI selection guidance
 - Adder proposed as a formal SSSI feature
- Specialist's SSSI review
 - New adder features on existing SSSIs?
 - Brand new SSSIs for adders?
- Site conservation objectives (integrated advice)



Wider Countryside Management





- Existing Agri-environment Schemes (esp. HLS)
 - Buffer strips project
- Countryside Stewardship
 - Targeting for herps
 - Internal advice/training
 - Internal herp network
 - Threatened species supplement








Species Conservation
